ORDER:-

The Government in the notification-II of G.O. read above have reduced the stamp duty from 3% to 1% payable in respect of **release deeds** under Article 46(A) of Schedule-1A to Indian Stamp Act, 1899, when the deeds relate to release of rights in favour of family members.

2) The Government after careful examination of the matter decided to rescind the notification II of the G.O. read above with an intention to restore the original stamp duty as prescribed under the respective articles.

Accordingly, the following notification will be published in an extraordinary issue of Andhra Pradesh Gazette, dated **20-09.2010**.
